

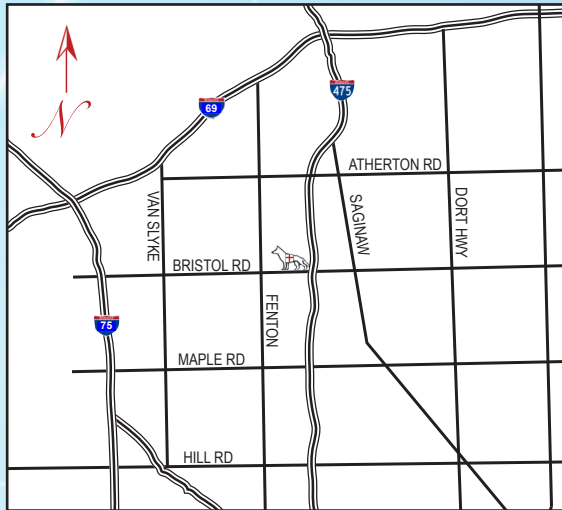

At the Animal Emergency Hospital, we feel pets are part of the family. We constantly strive to deliver compassionate care and quality medicine for your pet. As the only 24-hour hospital serving the Greater Flint region, we are pleased to assist your family pet with any medical condition that might arise.

AEH is a state-of-the-art emergency facility fully equipped with digital x-ray, ultrasound, in-house lab machines for blood and urine, advanced anesthetic monitoring devices, oxygen cages, and critical patient monitoring capabilities.

We offer 24-hour critical care and monitoring for your pets with a veterinarian staffed at our hospital at all times. We keep in close contact with you, the owner, regarding your pet's condition. Our doctors will call twice daily to update you on your pet's progress and our support staff is always available to give additional updates on your pet's care. Upon discharge, you will receive written discharge instructions detailing your pet's medical condition, medications, and exercise/dietary restrictions as well as any follow up care needed with your veterinarian.

As a direct extension of your family veterinarian, we work hand-in-hand with them to ensure seamless, continuity of care. Your vet is provided with your pet's medical records regarding all treatments and diagnostics after your pet is examined and treated at our hospital. We also stay in daily contact with your veterinarian while your pet is being cared for at AEH, keeping them up to date on your pet's progress.

### **Should I call before coming in?**

If possible, we would appreciate a call to let us know to expect you and so that we are prepared upon your arrival. Once arriving, please ring the doorbell to be admitted into the building. Please be sure to bring any medications that your pet is currently taking so that we have a complete medical history.

### **What will happen once I arrive with my pet?**

Upon arrival, all pets are triaged (briefly examined and categorized as critical or stable). Some pets need immediate care due to the severity of their illness and will be seen ahead of other pets that arrived before them. If at any time you feel your pet is declining, please let our staff know so that repeat assessment may be performed.

### **What payment options do you offer?**

Payment for all services is expected at that time of the service. We accept cash, check, and all major credit cards (VISA, MasterCard, Discover, Amex). We also offer financing through Care Credit.
